RECOMMENDED ICE THICKNESS



2" or Less – STAY OFF!

4" Generally safe for Ice Fishing – Foot Travel

5 inches – Snowmobile



8 to 12 inches – Car or Small Pickup

12 to 15 inches – Medium Truck

Remember: Ice is NEVER safe. Even if ice is a foot thick in one area, just a few feet away it can be only inches thick. ~ NEVER trust ice. It's safety can be influenced by many things. ~
